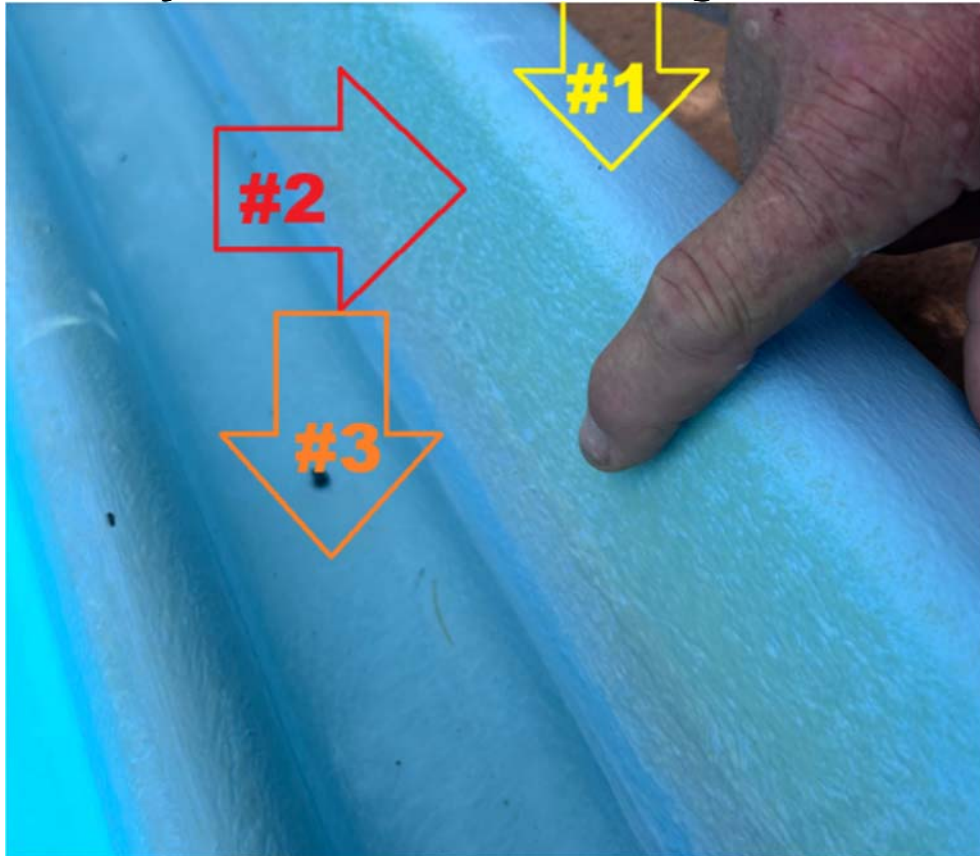

Recently Painted FG Pool Showing Brown Stains



On looking at this image and referencing the numbers:

1. **Top lip**, fully exposed to weather, sun and generally limited pool water in splash zone. No colour change.
2. **In the splash zone** and partial gutter, maybe when pool over filled (rain) and thus often at the water line. Often fine dust, body oils, suntan and similar, that float on the water, leave a “tide” line as the water recedes over time. Any water droplets splashed there will look more like globules and not flatten due to oil residues (try droplets in #1).
3. **Bottom of gutter**, no issues as water level is generally such this area remains under water and no surface contamination, unless water level drops this low. (unusual).

Best to check above factors by using a Green – Yellow Scotchbrite pad and some dishwashing detergent on small areas of the “brown” stain. If easy to remove, good. However, it can require quite a bit of rubbing as it has become well attached in the sun with oils and dust, to be almost baked on. Use Yellow side first, then Green if needed. Can try mild abrasive (Vim, Baking Soda) on same Scotchbrite. Also start with Yellow side followed by Green side if needs be. If successful, continue carefully in affected areas being sure not to remove the paint. If no success let us know. See below.
