SWIMMING POOL COATING

MAINTENANCE PLAN

Having a “new” pool surface, its life expectancy can be enhanced by some regular maintenance.

Paint n Forget is a hard-wearing durable, attractive and functional coating. It resists the effects of pool water, chlorine, wear and tear and UV as well, however it will keep on looking good for longer, if it has some regular maintenance just like any pool surface.

Out lined below is a suggested maintenance plan.

Maintenance				Inspections

Surrounds and non-slip traffic areas	x			Repair and touch up any areas of worn or chipped coating
Water surface interface area on sides		x		Check for worn or chipped coating. Lower water level and repair, touch up. Check for slime and body fat build up and clean
Pool sides and bottom. Visual inspection for any blisters, flaking paint or worn areas. Check for cracking in paint that could indicate movement of concrete in pool structure.		x		If blisters are small (less than 5mm) and few, leave until annual maintenance period. Significant blistering, worn areas or cracking will need to be addressed so drain pool and inspect.
Drain pool and full inspection of coating, walls and floors, all inlet and outlet fittings and surrounds.			x	Detergent scrub and hose out. Treat any algae present with 3 -5% chlorine solution and hose out. Any blisters, cracking or lifting paint to be sanded back and repaired as necessary once pool completely dry.
Ensure any repairs are discussed with Hitchins Technologies (HT) and undertaken by a HT approved applicator. Ensure concrete is completely dry (see Application Notes) prior to any paint being applied and refer INFO Sheet Maintaining Your Pool Water and Coating for Maximum Life.
